

TOP TEN THINGS TO DO IN THE AREA

1. **Marble Arch Caves** offering guided tours of the Caves daily during Easter, June to September. Tours last 1¼ hours and include an underground boat journey. t: 048 66348855
2. **Florence Court House**, enjoy a tour of the house to discover the stories of the Cole family and their working Irish Estate. Florencecourt, Enniskillen, BT921DB. T:04866348249.
3. **Global Geopark**, waterfalls, old abbeys, megalithic tombs, forests, fabulous landscapes and amazing show caves are among some of the attractions. An ongoing programme of events takes place in the Geopark, a living, breathing place where you can explore and enjoy the wonder of the natural environment.
4. **Shannon Pot**, Glangevlin as the source of Ireland 's longest river, the Shannon Pot is located off the R206 between Glangevlin and Blacklion. The Shannon Pot is a Marble Arch Caves Global Geopark site.
Tullydermot Falls, Glangevlin. The waterfalls are situated on the R200, approximately 6km south-west of Swanlinbar in the direction of the Bellavally Gap and Glangevlin. Also a Marble Arch Caves Global Geopark site.
Altacullion Viewpoint, Swanlinbar, enjoy the stunning vies of West Cavan from this viewpoint. Altacullion is located on the R200 between Derrynacreeve Junction and Glangevlin. Also a Marble Arch Caves Global Geopark site.
5. **Bear Essentials Centre & Showroom**, Tiernawannagh, Bawnboy t: 049 952 3461. Visit the showroom and watch handcrafted teddy bears being made, or take a workshop and make your own bear. www.irishbears.com
6. **Canoe Centre**, Carratraw Bridge, Butlersbridge. t: 086 8326861. Guided full/half day canoe trips around beautiful Lough Oughter. Opens June.
7. **Fermanagh County Museum**, once home of the Gaelic Maguire chieftains and the 17th century Watergate. Open all year. Enniskillen, t: 048 66325000.
8. **Belleek Pottery Visitor Centre**, home to the world famous Belleek Fine Parian China and Belleek Visitor Centre. Visitors can partake in guided tours, take a walk around the on-site museum, visit the audio visual theatre and showroom and enjoy refreshments in the restaurant.
