Green Hospitality Award members have voluntarily agreed to adopt and implement actions and strategies that will deliver on the core elements of the **Green Hospitality Award** Programme. These are;

- To ensure viable, long-term economic operations, providing socio-economic benefits to all stakeholders that are fairly distributed, including stable employment and income-earning opportunities
- To make optimal use of environmental resources and minimise consumption of Energy & Water and production of Waste, whilst respecting local natural heritage and biodiversity
