

Members return to competitive golf protocols

Online Booking

- All members must book a time on BRS to be eligible to play on a given day.
- If a slot is only booked by one or two members, other members are entitled to enter their name into the slot to make up a 4 ball.
- Members may only play once per day(In Competitions)

Competition Sign in and score entry

- If a member is looking to enter a competition, the computer will be available in the club house. Anyone using the computer must use sanitiser provided to clean your hands after use. Sanitising wipes must also be used to clean the screen after every use. Members will also be able to sign in through www.howdidido.com. We would encourage as many members to use the online facility as possible. A full user guide on how to use the online facility is provided at the end of this notice and it will be posted on the members notice board.
- Members must sign in before the start of their round. Entries during or after a round will not be accepted.
- Going forward, the club is no longer accepting cards as a form of score entry. All members must enter their score on the computer in the club house or through the howdidido online service. We would encourage as many members to use the online facility as possible. A full user guide on how to use the online facility is provided at the end of this notice and it will be posted on the members notice board.
 - If a member does not enter their score using one of the above, your score will be considered as an NR.
 - Cards may be used to track scores on the course, but do not need to be countersigned and members are asked not to swap cards with their playing partners. Cards should not be returned to the competition box.
 - When entering your score on the computer or on howdidido, your playing partner is required to call out the score of each hole as you enter your score for each hole. At the end of each 9, you confirm your score as displayed on screen with your playing partner. You may only submit your score if both scores match.
 - When a score is entered onto the computer or on howdidido, your score will be deemed as returned and no further actions are needed. Please note that when a card is confirmed, scores cannot be altered.

Competition Payments

Competition payments can be made in the normal way by putting your entry into an envelope with your name, date and the competition written on the envelope and put into the competition box. We are asking for all members to pay by notes only and refrain from using coins.

Competitions

Due to government restrictions and the golf course being closed and to meet social distancing guidelines, the following competitions have been cancelled:

All fixtures in the fixture book.

- Order of Merit
- The Doubles Matchplay.
- Our 3 majors – Men's Captains Prize, Lady's Captains Prize, and the Presidents Prize.

The committee has decided to retain the singles match-play and the winter league. The single match-play deadline for entry is on Sunday 5th July at 17.00. Any member wishing to enter the match-play must put their entry fee of €10 into an envelope with their name, number and competition name 'singles matchplay' and put in the competition box. Any entries after this date will not be accepted.

Order of Merit

The 2020 Order of merit will not be going ahead this year as Over half of the Order of Merit competitions have been missed due to the course been closed and competitions being prohibited by the GUI. As a result,

The committee has decided to run a summer league from 4th July until 20th September. A full list of the new fixtures for the remainder of the year will be posted on the members notice board.

On course rule changes

- Flag sticks are to remain in the hole at all times, no exception. Removing the flag will result in a 1 shot penalty.
- Rakes will be removed from all bunkers and will remain in play. All golfers are asked to smooth out bunkers using their feet and club. 6-inch placing will be allowed in all bunkers.
- Ball washers and water fountains are not to be used and will be covered.

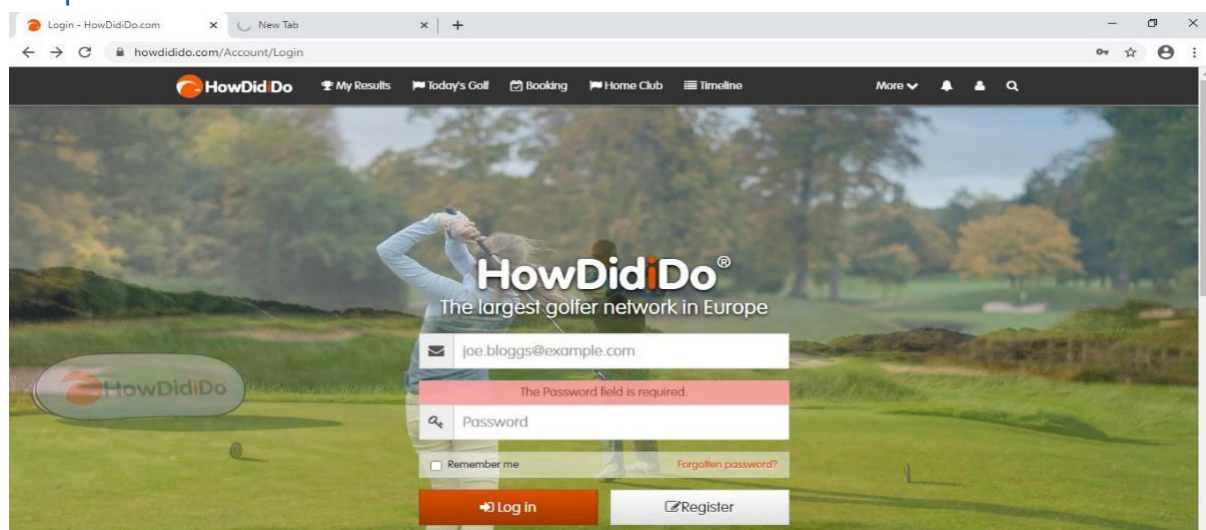

User Guide for Online sign in and score entry

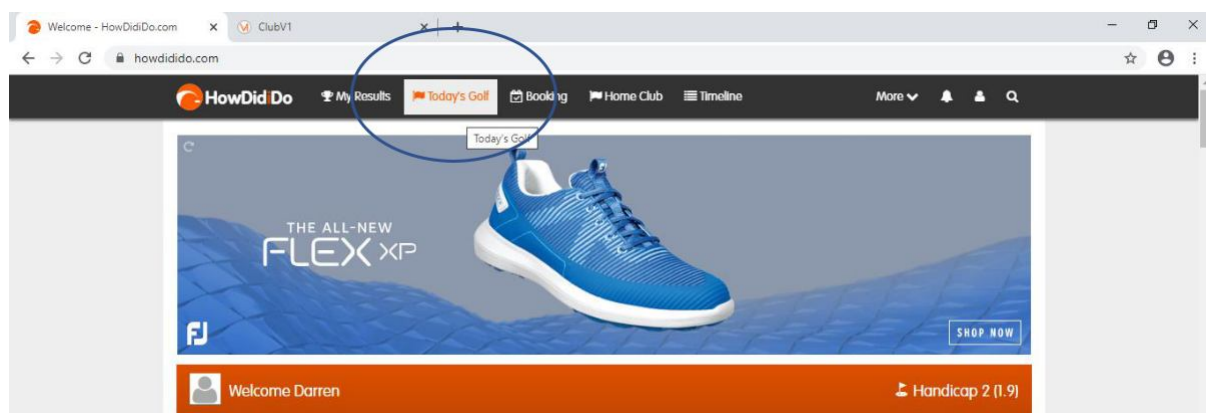
ClubV1 has provided an online sign in and score entry option for our members. This will allow members the opportunity to sign into competitions and enter their score from their mobile phone, tablet, or computer. The option of using the computer in the club house is still available for members to use, but we would encourage as many people to use the online facility. Please see a guide below on how to use this online service.

Step 1



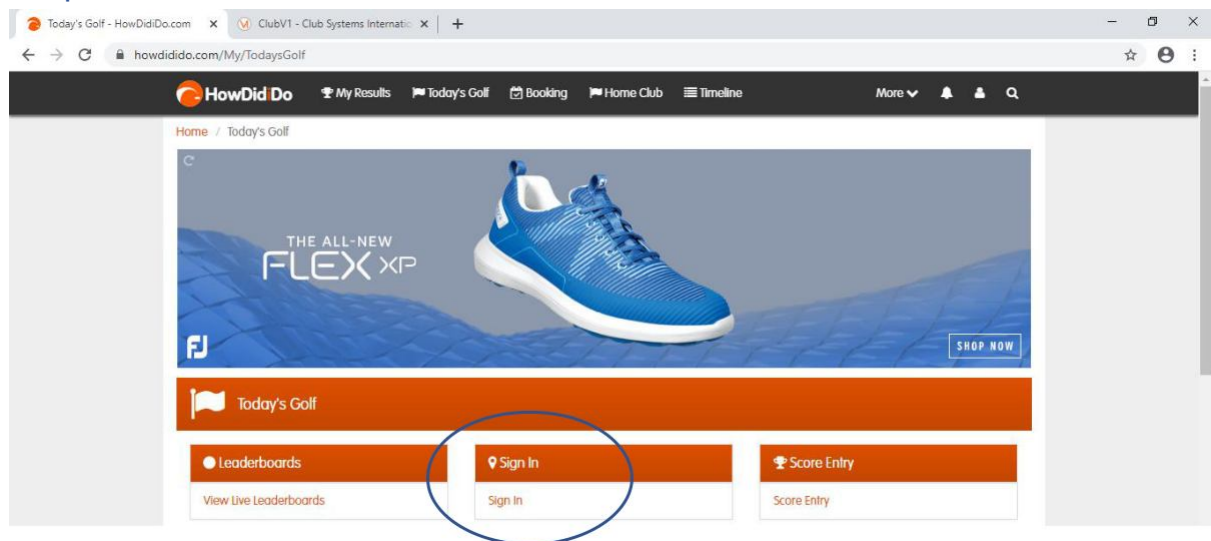
In your web browser, type www.howdidido.com. The above screen will pop up. If you have an account with howdidido, login. If not, you will need to register by clicking on the register button and following the step by step guide. Please note that you will need your GUI number to register an account with howdidido.

Step 2

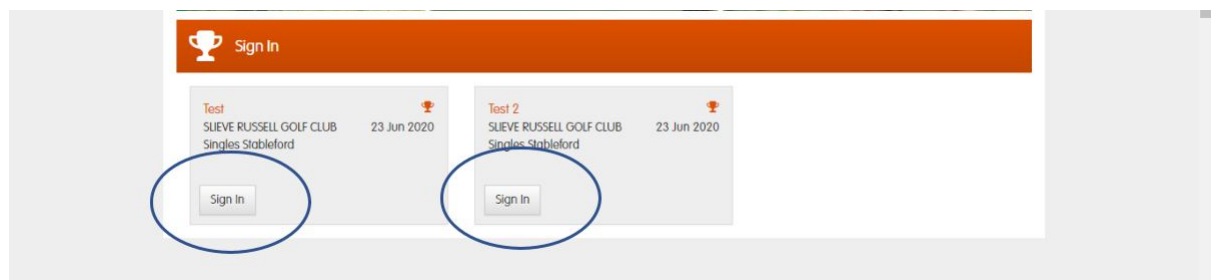


When signed in, you will be directed to the howdidido home page. Click on 'Today's golf' located on the top of the page just under the web address.

Step 3



This will bring you to the above page. To sign in, please click on sign in and select the competition that you wish to enter.



Step 4



After your round, log back into www.howdidido.com and click on 'today's golf' as per steps 1 and 2 above. Then click enter score and select the competition you wish to enter a score for. This will then bring you to the below screen.

Use the + and – arrows to select your score on each hole. When your score is entered for a hole, click on the arrow on the bottom right, as shown above, to go to the next hole. Repeat this process until you have entered your score for 18 holes.
