## LOCAL RULES

### OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

- (a). Over any boundary, fence or hedge.
- (b). On or over the road to the back of the ninth hole.

### MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-1)

Stones in bunkers, red and yellow hazard posts and direction signs.

### IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)

- (a). All sprinkler heads and hydrant covers.
- (b). Bridges, roads and pathways.
- (c). Tee markers, signs, seats, litter bins and distance markers.
- (d). Staked trees.
- (e). Buildings on the course.
- (f). Water tap at ninth green.

The wall to the right of the sixth green is an integral part of the course.

### WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

All ponds and rivers marked by yellow posts.

### LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

All ponds and ditches marked by red posts.  
N.B. Part of bridge over hazard is part of the hazard.

### PRACTICE GREEN

Ball must be lifted and dropped at nearest point of relief, not nearer the ninth hole.

### GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25-1)

- (a). Areas are defined by barrier hoops or by white lines.
- (b). Vehicle tyre marks.
